### **Instructions to Prospective Bidders:**

In every instance in which this addendum conflicts with information provided elsewhere in the bid documents and previous addenda, instructions provided in this addendum shall apply unless subsequently replaced by a later addendum.

## **PROJECT INFORMATION**

**Changes and additions are shown in red type.**

### **Section 3. WARRANTY**

- a. Contractor shall provide a **one** year parts and labor warranty which begins after system commissioning and Authority acceptance of installation. Service call shall be conducted during normal business hours (8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.) Contractor shall respond to all service calls within two hours of first phone call and be on site within four hours. As base OnSSI SUPs end 30 days after Contractor software purchase, one additional year has been added as part of this request.
- b. **Ten (10)** months after system acceptance, Contractor shall conduct a warranty completion re-commissioning and shall resolve all problems which are under warranty. This re-commissioning shall be performed in the presence of Owner/Owner's Representative.

### **Add:**

- c. **The chosen contractor will be required to investigate, as necessary, any operational failures to determine the source or cause of any problems during the one year warranty period. The chosen contractor will, during the warranty period, provide this service at no additional cost.**

**If it is determined that the cause of any such problem is related to equipment that was purchased outside of this contract, the chosen contractor will provide a written estimate to the Authority for repairing or replacing the necessary**

**equipment including labor for installation. The Authority will then determine whether to undertake the repair utilizing funds other than those provided for with this grant. See the answer to Question 3 below for a list of cameras that will be covered by this investigation period.**

### **BID FORM**

Please see REVISED BID FORM which is available online for download. Bidders can ignore the "BID FORM" section on Addendum A and fill out the REVISED BID FORM which includes those items listed on Addendum A.

### **ADDENDUM A**

Note that bidders do not need to fill out the BID FORM section of Addendum A because that information is to be listed on the "REVISED BID FORM" which can be downloaded. Bidders are still required to Acknowledge Addendum A and Addendum B by signing where indicated and submitting both signature pages with bids.

### **QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS**

**Q1a.** We have a question on the intent of the Maintenance Agreement and warranty. (P. 9, item #3 and on the bid form, p. #35) Is the intent to cover both the existing equipment from Phase #1 AND the new equipment in Phase #2 or just to serve as an extended (2 year) warranty on the new items in the RFP? Does the maintenance request have any connection to the present system from Phase #1?

**Q1b.** Please clarify intent of Page 9, Section 3, item b. "Twenty two (22) months after system acceptance..." System includes 1 year warranty. This is contradicting statement. Does this apply only if the second year warranty is accepted? Is it excluded if the second year warranty is not accepted?

**Q1c.** Page #9, Part #3a of the warranty portion of the specifications calls for a TWO YEAR parts and labor warranty, which commences after commissioning. Page #35, Section B of the bid form (under Maintenance Agreement) calls for a ONE YEAR part and labor warranty.

**A1. Please see "PROJECT INFORMATION" section above which includes two changes and one additional paragraph.**

Q2. Re: The Trigen roof mounting pole. (Item #16) The specifications call for replacing the existing pole. It was our understanding on the walk-through that we could re-use the existing pole. Please qualify.

**A2. The pole shall be replaced per the specification**

**Q3.** Need to know the make, model, location of, Type of (IP or analog) and total number of cameras currently on existing VMS system.
