YARD WASTE WILL NOT BE COLLECTED DURING WEEKS WITH A HOLIDAY!

PLEASE NOTE: Yard waste will be collected each Wednesday (except holiday weeks) until December 1, 2010. Weekly yard waste pick-up will resume March 2, 2011. If you must dispose of grass clippings, do not place unbagged clippings in the bottom of the cart. To avoid sticking, either put clippings in a bag (paper bags are preferred) in the bottom or place bulkier yard waste, such as leaves or branches, at the bottom of the cart. Yard waste will **NOT** be collected from roll carts from December 1, 2010 until March 2, 2011.
