QUESTIONS & RESPONSES

- Q. Specifications require body and lid to be formed from medium density polyethylene. Will the City also accept high density polyethylene for the lids?
- R. Yes.
- Q. The specifications stat the use of the carts for “City Government Office Buildings”. Does the City need a cart for indoor use, with casters, perhaps (cannot be collected with automated arm, but can be collected with semi-automated collection lifters)?
- R. No. Same style cart we are using now, Model #76596, EVR1, round body.
- Q. We have assumed that these carts’ contents will be collected with an automated arm truck. However, does the City need a lower lift bar (stop bar for semi-automated collection) on carts?
- R. No.
- Q. The City has clearly stated that two or more bids submitted for one item will be rejected. If possible, will the City describe any way that bidders may present more than one item for the specifications, with each item having its own pricing?
- R. No. The bidder will have to choose the one item that comes closest to the specification. Any bidder that submits two bids for any item will be disqualified.
