

ORDINANCE #65239
Board Bill No. 97

An Ordinance, recommended and approved by the Airport Commission and the Board of Estimate and Apportionment, ratifying and adopting the actions of the Mayor and the Comptroller of the City of St. Louis (the "City") in accepting and executing on behalf of the City a certain "AMENDMENT NUMBER 1" dated May 23, 2001, which is filed in the Office of the City Register and is incorporated herein, to the "Grant Agreement" for Project Number 3-29-0085-45, Contract Number DTFA09-97-A-40056, dated September 29, 1997, authorized by Ordinance 64187 approved November 17, 1997, for a maximum federal obligation of One Million Two Hundred Thousand Dollars(\$1,200,000), AMENDMENT NUMBER 1 amends the description of the development to be accomplished under the project; amending Section One of Ordinance 64187 by deleting and substituting certain words as provided for in Section Three of this Ordinance; and containing an emergency clause.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE. The actions of the Mayor and the Comptroller in accepting and executing on behalf of the City of St. Louis (the "City") an "AMENDMENT NUMBER 1" dated May 23, 2001, which is filed in the Office of the City Register and is incorporated herein, to the "Grant Agreement" for Project Number 3-29-0085-45, Contract Number DTFA09-97-A-40056, dated September 29, 1997, authorized by Ordinance 64187 approved November 17, 1997, for a maximum federal obligation of One Million Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,200,000), is hereby ratified and approved.

SECTION TWO. All terms, conditions, statements, warranties, representations, covenants, agreements, and assurances contained in the project application and the incorporated materials referred to in the Grant Agreement, which is filed in the Office of the City Register, not inconsistent with AMENDMENT NUMBER 1 are hereby ratified and approved and made a part hereof.

SECTION THREE. Section One of Ordinance 64187 approved November 17, 1997 is hereby amended by deleting the following words:

"for the installation of a Noise Management System;"
and substituting the following:

"for the installation of a Noise Management System and to reimburse for land acquired in fee for Noise Mitigation as shown on the attached Parcel Listing;"

SECTION FOUR. This being an ordinance providing for a Public Work and Improvement Program, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure as defined in Article IV, Section 20 of the City's Charter, and shall become effective immediately upon approval of the Mayor of the City.
