

ORDINANCE #65242
Board Bill No. 100

An Ordinance, recommended and approved by the Airport Commission and the Board of Estimate and Apportionment, ratifying and adopting the actions of the Mayor and the Comptroller in accepting and executing on behalf of the City of St. Louis a certain grant agreement offered by the United States of America (the "Grant Agreement"), acting through the Federal Aviation Administration of the United States Department of Transportation, the Grant Agreement being for Project Number 3-29-0085-62, Contract Number DTFA 09-01-A-40022, dated May 8, 2001, for a maximum federal obligation of Four Million Nine Hundred Eighty Two Thousand Five Hundred Sixty Seven Dollars (\$4,982,567), which is filed in the Office of the City Register, to rehabilitate RW / Airfield Lighting/Electrical Vault (Phase I); and containing an emergency clause.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE. The actions of the Mayor and the Comptroller in accepting and executing on behalf of the City of St. Louis (the "City"), a grant agreement offered by the United States of America (the "Grant Agreement"), acting through the Federal Aviation Administration of the United States Department of Transportation, the Grant Agreement being for Project Number 3-29-0085-62, Contract Number DTFA 09-01-A-40022, dated May 8, 2001, for a maximum federal obligation of Four Million Nine Hundred Eighty Two Thousand Five Hundred Sixty Seven Dollars (\$4,982,567), which is filed in the Office of the City Register and made a part hereof, for the activities authorized in the Grant Agreement to Rehabilitate RW / Airfield Lighting/Electrical Vault (Phase I).

SECTION TWO. All terms, conditions, statements, warranties, representations, covenants, agreements, and assurances contained in the project application and the incorporated materials referred to in the Grant Agreement are hereby ratified and approved and made a part hereof.

SECTION THREE. This being an ordinance providing for a Public Work and Improvement Program, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure as defined in Article IV, Section 20 of the City's Charter, and shall become effective immediately upon approval of the Mayor of the City.
