

ORDINANCE #65437
Board Bill No. 269

An ordinance recommended by the Board of Estimate and Apportionment appropriating the sum of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) from the Health Care Trust Fund for current expenses of the city government and containing an emergency clause.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE. There is hereby appropriated and set apart the sum of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) from revenue available in the Health Care Trust Fund which has been received pursuant to the imposition of a Local Use Tax, to the Regional Health Commission for its use in providing public health care services within the City of St. Louis

SECTION TWO. All requests for disbursements of the funds appropriated in Section One of this ordinance shall bear the approval of the Regional Health Commission and shall state in a manner acceptable to the Comptroller, the intended use of the requested disbursement. Funds appropriated in Section One of this Ordinance shall not be disbursed for any purpose without specific approval of that purpose by the Board of Estimate and Apportionment.

SECTION THREE. Emergency Clause. This being an Ordinance for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure within the meaning of Sections 19 and 20 of Article IV of the Charter of the City of St. Louis and therefore this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
