

ORDINANCE #65492
Board Bill No. 361

An Ordinance recommended and approved by the Board of Estimate and Apportionment pertaining to health care services, authorizing and directing the Comptroller of the City of St. Louis, on behalf of the City, to enter into an Agreement with St. Louis ConnectCare to provide health care services, appropriating one million five hundred thousand dollars for said services and containing an emergency clause.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE. The Comptroller of the City of St. Louis is hereby authorized and directed to enter into an Agreement with St. Louis ConnectCare to provide health care services. Said Agreement is attached hereto as Exhibit One and is made a part hereof.

SECTION TWO. There is hereby appropriated one million five hundred thousand dollars to ConnectCare from local use tax receipts accruing to Fund 1110, Health Care Trust Fund, pursuant to Ordinance 65121 for the purpose of providing health care services within the City of St. Louis, as required under said Agreement.

SECTION THREE. Emergency Clause. This being an Ordinance for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety, it is hereby declared to be an immediate measure within the meaning of Sections 19 and 20 of Article IV of the Charter of the City of St. Louis and therefore this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
