An ordinance extending the boundaries of the Central West End Historic District and containing an emergency clause.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE. In accordance with the Historic Preservation Certification Application filed with the United States Department of the Interior and attached hereto as Exhibit A, the following described area is hereby designated as part of the Central West End Historic District as heretofore established by Ordinance 56768, as amended:

Lots numbered 1, 2, 3 and the east 40 feet of Lot Number 4 of Olive and Kingshighway Addition and in City Block Number 3879-N of the City of St. Louis, having an aggregate front of 195 feet and 4 7/8 inches on the south line of Delmar Boulevard by a depth southwardly of 135 feet to an alley. Known and numbered as 625 North Euclid Avenue.

SECTION TWO: A general location map of the area shall be maintained on file in the office of the Register. The historic district standards to be applied to the area described in Section One shall be those standards adopted for the Central West End Historic District.

SECTION THREE. Emergency clause.

This being an ordinance for the preservation of public peace, health, and safety, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure within the meaning of Sections 19 and 20 of Article IV of the Charter of the City of St. Louis and therefore shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the mayor.
