

**ORDINANCE 365926
Board Bill No. 17**

An ordinance pertaining to the Mechanical Code; amending Ordinance 65021 which adopted the International Mechanical Code, 2000 Edition, as the Mechanical Code of the City of Saint Louis by repealing Table 106.5.2, Section 106.5.3 and Table 106.5.3 of Section Three of Ordinance 65021 and enacting a new Table 106.5.2 FEES FOR MECHANICAL PERMITS AND INSPECTIONS; and containing a savings clause and an emergency clause.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SAINT LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:

Section One.

Ordinance 65021, approved September 8, 2000, is hereby amended by repealing Table 106.5.2, Section 106.5.3 and Table 106.5.3 of Section Three and enacting a new Table 106.5.2 FEES FOR MECHANICAL PERMITS AND INSPECTIONS.

NOTES:

- 1 All installations of refrigeration and/or air conditioning equipment require a permit except the following:
 - a Portable equipment (window units)
 - b Units of less than 12,000 BTU per hour capacity.
 - c Incremental (through the wall) cooling or heating/cooling units.
 - d Condensing units serving building of six units or less.
- 2 Reinspections - Faulty or Incomplete work - Where a reinspection is required to be made due to faulty workmanship or work not complete at the time of a requested inspection, a reinspection charge of \$25.00 shall be levied

Section Two.

That nothing in this Ordinance or in the Mechanical Code hereby adopted shall be construed to affect any suit or proceeding impending in any court, or any rights acquired, or liability incurred, or any cause or causes of action acquired or existing, under any act or ordinance hereby repealed as cited in Sections One thru Three of this Ordinance; nor shall any just or legal right or remedy of any character be lost, impaired or affected by this ordinance.

Section Three.

This being an ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public safety, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall become effective immediately upon its approval by the Mayor.
