

**ORDINANCE #65934**  
**Board Bill No. 115**

An ordinance authorizing and directing the Director of Streets to close, barricade or otherwise impede the flow of pedestrian and vehicle traffic on 17<sup>th</sup> Street by blocking said traffic flow at a point seventy-five (75) feet north of the north curblineline of Papin Street, and containing an emergency clause.

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION ONE:** The Director of Streets is hereby authorized to close, barricade or otherwise impede the flow of pedestrian and vehicle traffic on 17<sup>th</sup> Street by permitting the blocking of said traffic flow at a point seventy-five (75) feet north of the north curblineline of Papin Street.

**SECTION TWO:** Emergency Clause. This being an ordinance for the preservation of public peace, health and safety, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure within the meaning of Sections 19 and 20 of Article IV of the Charter of the City of St. Louis and therefore this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
