

ORDINANCE #68699
Board Bill No. 14

An ordinance pertaining to curfew in Buder Park; repealing Ordinance 66988, codified in Section 22.18.026 of the Revised Code of the City of St. Louis as prohibiting idling, wandering, strolling, playing or otherwise being in or upon the confines of Buder Park or the public areas immediately adjacent thereto between the hours of 7:00 p.m. and 10:00 a.m. throughout the year; containing an emergency clause.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE. Ordinance 66988, codified in Section 22.18.026 of the Revised Code of the City of St. Louis is hereby repealed and enacted in lieu thereof is the following:

SECTION TWO. Notwithstanding the provisions of any other ordinance to the contrary, no person shall idle, wander, stroll, play or otherwise be in or upon the confines of Buder Park or the public areas immediately adjacent thereto between the hours of 7:00 p.m. and 10:00 a.m. throughout the year.

SECTION THREE. Emergency clause.

This being an ordinance for the preservation of public peace, health, and safety, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure within the meaning of Sections 19 and 20 of Article IV of the Charter of the City of St. Louis and therefore shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the mayor.
