

Board Bill Number 208 INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN FRANK WILLIAMSON

1 An ordinance authorizing and directing the Circuit Attorney, on behalf of the City of St. Louis, to
2 enter into a contract with the United States Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance, Office
3 of Justice Programs for funding to create a crime analysis-based diversion project within the Office of the
4 Circuit Attorney (also referred to as the Redirect Program) and authorizing the Circuit Attorney to
5 expend the contract grant funds necessary to support this effort including the hiring of personnel; and
6 containing an emergency clause.

7 WHEREAS, the Circuit Attorney of the City of St. Louis has been awarded a grant contract with
8 the United States Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance, Office of Justice Programs for the
9 purpose of staffing a crime analysis-based diversion project within the Office of the Circuit Attorney; and

10 WHEREAS, the United States has provided funding in the amount of \$417,512.00 to the Circuit
11 Attorney's Office for the purpose of providing additional staff and resources for this project in addition
12 to, and not to supplant or replace, their existing allocation; and

13 **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:**

14 **SECTION ONE.** The Circuit Attorney is hereby authorized and directed to enter into and execute
15 a contract with the United States Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance and Office of
16 Justice Programs for a contract to fund a crime analysis-based diversion project.

17 **SECTION TWO.** The Circuit Attorney is hereby authorized and directed, upon approval of the
18 Board of Estimate and Apportionment, to expend the funds received pursuant to the contract, by
19 contract or otherwise, in a manner and purpose that is consistent with the provisions of said Contract.

20 **SECTION THREE.** Emergency Clause. This being an ordinance for the preservation of public
21 peace, health and safety, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure within the meaning of
