

ORDINANCE NUMBER 70191

INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN JEFFREY L. BOYD

1 An ordinance authorizing and directing the Fire Commissioner, on behalf of the Mayor
2 and the City of Saint Louis, to enter into and execute a Grant Agreement with the U.S.
3 Department of Homeland Security, Federal Emergency Management Agency, Assistance to
4 Firefighters Grant, to fund the 2014 Fire Prevention and Safety Get Alarmed Program, upon
5 approval of the Board of Estimate and Apportionment, and to expend funds by entering into
6 contracts or otherwise for grant purposes and containing an emergency clause.

7 **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:**

8 **SECTION ONE.** The Mayor and Fire Commissioner are hereby authorized and
9 directed, on behalf of the City of St. Louis, to enter into and execute a Grant Agreement with the
10 U.S. Department of Homeland Security, Federal Emergency Management Agency, Assistance to
11 Firefighters Grant, to fund the 2014 Fire Prevention and Safety Get Alarmed Grant to fund
12 firefighter and civilian safety through the distribution of and training on smoke detectors and CO
13 alarms.

14 **SECTION TWO.** The Fire Commissioner is hereby authorized and directed, upon
15 approval of the Board of Estimate and Apportionment, to expend the funds, which are hereby
16 appropriated for said purpose, by entering into contracts or otherwise received pursuant to the
17 2014 Grant Agreement, totaling \$206,262.00, in a manner that is consistent with the provisions
18 of said Agreement, a copy of which is attached hereto and shall become part of the ordinance.

19 **SECTION THREE.** Emergency Clause. This being an Ordinance for the immediate
20 preservation of public peace, health and safety, it is hereby declared to be an immediate measure
21 within the meaning of Sections 19 and 20 of Article IV of the Charter of the City of St. Louis
