

ORDINANCE NUMBER 70265

1 **BOARD BILL NO. 320 INTRODUCED BY ALDERWOMAN DONNA BARINGER**

2 An ordinance repealing Ordinance 66922 pertaining to a certain temporary street  
3 closing and enacting a new ordinance in lieu thereof authorizing and directing the Director of  
4 Streets to close, barricade, or otherwise impede the flow of traffic on McCausland Avenue by  
5 blocking said traffic flow at a point 156 feet west of the west curb line of Chippewa Street  
6 and further authorizing and directing the Director of Streets to close, barricade or otherwise  
7 impede the flow of traffic on Plainview Avenue by blocking said traffic flow at a point 155  
8 feet west of the west curb line of Jamieson Avenue and further authorizing and directing the  
9 Director of Streets to close, barricade or otherwise impede the flow of traffic on Hiview  
10 Avenue by blocking said traffic flow at a point 155 feet west of the west curb line of  
11 Jamieson Avenue, and containing an emergency clause.

12 **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:**

13 **SECTION ONE.** Ordinance 66922 is hereby repealed and the following ordinance  
14 is adopted pertaining to the same subject matter.

15 **SECTION TWO.** The Director of Streets is hereby authorized to close and barricade  
16 McCausland Avenue at a point 156 feet west of the west curb line of Chippewa Street.

17 **SECTION THREE.** The Director of Streets is hereby authorized to close and  
18 barricade Plainview Avenue at a point 155 feet west of the west curb line of Jamieson  
19 Avenue.

20 **SECTION FOUR.** The Director of Streets is hereby authorized to close and  
21 barricade Hiview Avenue at a point 155 feet west of the west curb line of Jamieson Avenue.

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1           **SECTION FIVE. Emergency Clause.** This being an Ordinance for the  
2 preservation of public peace, health, and safety, it is hereby declared to be an emergency  
3 measure within the meaning of Sections 19 and 20 of Article IV of the Charter of the City of  
4 St. Louis and therefore this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage  
5 and approval by the Mayor.
