4 An ordinance amending Ordinance 69429 by repealing Section Two and Section Three of
5 that ordinance and enacting in lieu thereof a new Section Two and a new Section Three
6 pertaining to the same subject matters; and containing an emergency clause.

7 **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SAINT LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:**

8 **SECTION ONE. Repeal of Section Two of Ordinance 69429**

9 Ordinance 69429 is hereby amended by repealing Section Two of said Ordinance which
10 is presently codified as Section 11.60.310 of the Code and enacting in lieu thereof a new
11 Section Two which shall read as follows:

12 11.60.310

13 It is intended that the following persons shall continue to be prosecuted in State Court
14 rather than City Court:

- 15 i. Who are arrested on suspicion of any felony or misdemeanor arising from the same set
16 of facts and circumstances as the alleged marijuana offense; or
17 ii. Who possess marijuana packaged in a manner intended for sale or distribution;
18 iii. Who possesses over 35 grams of marijuana; or
19 iv. Who otherwise causes the City Counselor's Office to reasonably believe that a
20 request for handling by the Circuit Attorney is warranted.

21 **SECTION TWO.**

22 Ordinance 69429 is hereby amended by repealing Section Three of said Ordinance
23 which is presently codified as Section 11.60.320 of the Code and enacting in lieu thereof a new

1 Section Three which shall read as follows:

2 11.60.320

3 Any person violating this part shall be subject to a fine of not more than twenty-five dollars.

4 There is a strong presumption that the proper disposition of any such case is to suspend the

5 imposition of sentence and/or require community service work and/or drug counseling and

6 education.
