

ORDINANCE 70863

BOARD BILL NO. 141 INTRODUCED BY: ALDERWOMAN MEGAN GREEN

1 An ordinance pertaining to commercial semi-trailer trucks, also known as a semis, or
2 tractor-trailers; prohibiting such traffic along Utah Street from the west boundary of Grand
3 Boulevard to the east boundary of Morgan Ford Road, exempting from said prohibition
4 emergency vehicles, including privately owned tow trucks when providing emergency service
5 to non-commercial vehicles, vehicles making deliveries to nearby addresses, and vehicles
6 with a Gross Vehicle Weight (GVW) of less than 26,000 pounds, and containing an
7 emergency clause.

8 **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:**

9 **SECTION ONE.** No person shall drive, tow, or move any commercial truck, truck-tractor,
10 tractor, or commercial trailer with a Gross Vehicle Weight (GVW) in excess of 26,000
11 pounds on Utah Street from the west boundary of Grand Boulevard to the east boundary of
12 Morgan Ford Road.

13 **SECTION TWO.** The provisions of Section One of this ordinance shall not apply to
14 emergency vehicles, including privately owned tow trucks when providing emergency
15 service.

16 **SECTION THREE.** Section One of this ordinance shall not be construed as a prohibition
17 against any vehicle which is traveling directly to a destination for loading, unloading, or

1 servicing, if there is no alternative route to said destination on streets and alleys where truck
2 traffic is not prohibited.

3 **SECTION FOUR.** This being an ordinance for the preservation of public peace, health and
4 safety, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure within the meaning of Sections 19
5 and 20 of Article IV of the Charter of the City of St. Louis, and therefore, this ordinance shall
6 become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
