

**BOARD BILL NO. 94                    INTRODUCED BY ALDERMEN AND ALDERWOMEN  
CARTER, BOSLEY, VILLA, HANRAHAN, KIRNER, MOORE**

1    An ordinance pertaining to “The Equitable Relief From Utility Tax Fund”, amending Section  
2    Two of Ordinance 60564, codified in Paragraph C of Section 23.30.030 of the Revised Code of  
3    the City of St. Louis, and enacting in lieu thereof a new paragraph C pertaining to the same  
4    subject matter allowing for assistance in the payment of electric cooling service for low income  
5    City residents in addition to assistance in the payment of electric heating service, and containing  
6    an emergency clause.

7    **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SAINT LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:**

8    **SECTION ONE.** Section Two of Ordinance 60564, codified as Paragraph C of Section  
9    23.30.030 of the Revised Code of the City of Saint Louis is hereby repealed and in lieu thereof a  
10    new section is enacted to read as follows:

11    23.30.030 **Gross Receipts Tax**

12    C. There is hereby established "The Equitable Relief From Utility Tax Fund" to the credit of  
13    which fund the Comptroller is hereby directed and authorized to place the proceeds from such  
14    tax from those City residents directly aided by the Low Income Home Energy Assistance  
15    Program and the Dollar More Program. The amount of tax monthly beginning **July 1, 2008**, each  
16    year to be made available from appropriation in the general appropriation ordinance, in order to  
17    assist low income residents of the City of St. Louis in the payment of their electric heating **and**  
18    **cooling** service. The Missouri Division of Family Services and the Dollar More Program shall

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1 provide monthly statements to the Comptroller, in the form he approves, indicating the amount  
2 of gross revenue and tax paid through the program.

3 **SECTION TWO.** Effective Date. The provisions of this ordinance shall become effective  
4 June 30, 2008.

5 **SECTION THREE.** This ordinance being deemed necessary for the immediate preservation of  
6 the public health, welfare, and safety is hereby declared an emergency measure and shall become  
7 effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.

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
