

BOARD BILL NO. 236 INTRODUCED BY ALDERWOMAN PHYLLIS YOUNG

1 An ordinance recommended and approved by the Airport Commission and the Board of
2 Estimate and Apportionment, ratifying and adopting the actions of the Mayor and the
3 Comptroller of the City of St. Louis (the “City”), the owner and operator of Lambert-St. Louis
4 International Airport® (the “Airport”), in accepting and executing on behalf of the City a certain
5 grant agreement offered by the United States of America (the “Grant Agreement”), acting
6 through the Federal Aviation Administration of the United States Department of Transportation,
7 the Grant Agreement being for Project Number 3-29-0085-108-2008, dated September 3, 2008,
8 for a maximum federal obligation of Three Million Two Hundred Seven Thousand Eleven
9 Dollars (\$3,207,011.00), which is filed in the Office of the City Register [Comptroller Document
10 No. 57975], for the reimbursement of direct costs associated with the replacement of Runway
11 12L/30R Keel Section (Center 50’); and containing an emergency clause.

12 **BE IT SO ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:**

13 **SECTION ONE.** The actions of the Mayor and the Comptroller of the City of St. Louis
14 (the “City”), the owner and operator of Lambert-St. Louis International Airport® (the
15 “Airport”), in accepting and executing on behalf of the City a grant agreement offered by the
16 United States of America (the “Grant Agreement”), acting through the Federal Aviation
17 Administration of the United States Department of Transportation, the Grant Agreement being
18 for Project Number 3-29-0085-108-2008, dated September 3, 2008, for a maximum federal
19 obligation of Three Million Two Hundred Seven Thousand Eleven Dollars (\$3,207,011.00),
20 which is filed in the Office of the City Register [Comptroller Document No. 57975], for the

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1 reimbursement of direct costs associated with the replacement of Runway 12L/30R Keel Section
2 (Center 50'), is hereby ratified and approved.

3 **SECTION TWO.** All terms, conditions, statements, warranties, representations,
4 covenants, agreements, and assurances contained in the project application and the incorporated
5 materials referred to in the Grant Agreement are hereby ratified and approved and made a part
6 hereof.

7 **SECTION THREE.** This being an ordinance providing for a Public Work and
8 Improvement Program, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure as defined in Article
9 IV, Section 20 of the City Charter, and shall become effective immediately upon approval of the
10 Mayor of the City.

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
