

BOARD BILL NO. 251

INTRODUCED BY ALDERWOMAN PHYLLIS YOUNG

1 An ordinance repealing Ordinance No. 65110, which provided for the vacation of 3rd Street
2 between Miller Street and Rutger Street adjoining City Blocks 202 and 692 of the City of St.
3 Louis, Missouri.

4 **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS, AS FOLLOWS:**

5 **SECTION ONE.** Ordinance #65110, approved December 20, 2000, which vacated the public
6 surface rights of vehicle, equestrian and pedestrian travel, between the rights-of-way of 3rd
7 Street between the north line of Miller Street and the centerline of Rutger Street, as vacated by
8 Ordinance #52018, adjoining City Blocks 202 and 692 is hereby repealed.

9 **SECTION TWO.** The Board of Public Service is authorized to accept the rededication of the
10 public right-of-way described in Section One.

11 **SECTION THREE.** Emergency Claus. This being an ordinance for the preservation of public
12 peace, health and safety, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure within the meaning of
13 Sections 19 and 20 of Article IV of the Charter of the City of St. Louis and therefore shall
14 become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
