

1 **BOARD BILL NO. 311 INTRODUCED BY ALDERWOMAN PHYLLIS**
2 **YOUNG**

3 An Ordinance authorizing and directing the Chief of Police, on behalf of the
4 Mayor and the City of St. Louis, to enter into and execute a Grant Agreement with the
5 U.S. Department of Homeland Security, to fund the 2013 Port Security Grant Program,
6 upon approval of the Board of Estimate and Apportionment, and to expend funds by
7 entering into contracts or otherwise for grant purposes and containing an emergency
8 clause.

9 **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:**

10 **SECTION ONE.** The Mayor and Chief of Police are hereby authorized and
11 directed, on behalf of the City of St. Louis, to enter into and execute a Grant Agreement
12 with the U.S. Department of Homeland Security, to fund the 2013 Port Security Grant
13 Program.

14 **SECTION TWO.** The Chief of Police is hereby authorized and directed, upon
15 approval of the Board of Estimate and Apportionment, to expend the funds, which are
16 hereby appropriated for said purpose, by entering into contracts or otherwise received
17 pursuant to the 2013 Grant Agreement, totaling \$87,500.00, in a manner that is consistent
18 with the provisions of said Agreement, a copy of which is attached hereto and shall
19 become part of the ordinance.

20 **SECTION THREE.** Emergency Clause. This being an Ordinance for the
21 immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety, it is hereby declared to be an
22 immediate measure within the meaning of Sections 19 and 20 of Article IV of the

- 1 Charter of the City of St. Louis and therefore this Ordinance shall become effective
- 2 immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
