

St. Louis City Ordinance 62309

FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

BOARD BILL NO. [91] 28

INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN WILLIE WILLIAMS, SR.

An ordinance establishing a two (2) way stop intersection for all traffic approaching the intersection of Clay Avenue and Lexington Avenue, and designating the approach to said intersection on Clay Avenue as a stop intersection, for the purposes of regulating traffic on Clay Avenue approaching said intersection and containing a penalty clause.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE. An ordinance establishing a two (2) way stop intersection by designating Clay Avenue at Lexington Avenue as a stop intersection so as to regulate traffic traveling on Clay Avenue as the same approaches its intersection with Lexington Avenue as a stop intersection, as is set forth in Section 17.08.050 of the Revised Code of the City of St. Louis, 1980.

SECTION TWO. PENALTY CLAUSE. Any person, firm, or corporation violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a Class I General Offense.
