

# *St. Louis City Ordinance 62334*

FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

BOARD BILL NO. [91] 08

INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN MARTIE J. ABOUSSIE

An ordinance enacted pursuant to Section 56.540, Revised Statutes of Missouri to amend Ordinance No.62004 relating to the office of the Circuit Attorney of the City of St. Louis, allocating the positions established by said Section 56.540, R.S.Mo. to classes with grades and a schedule setting minimum and maximum salaries for such grades; providing that the Circuit Attorney's appointments to such positions be of such grades and within such range as he may determine; providing that such salaries be paid bi-weekly; providing for payment of overtime wages on an hourly basis at the bi-weekly rate to non-management classes of employees when such overtime is authorized as necessary by the Circuit Attorney; and containing an emergency clause.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE. The following positions of the Office of the Circuit Attorney of the City of St. Louis, authorized by Sect. 56.540, R.S.Mo., to a grade in the following Section with the rates therein established, to-wit:

SECTION TWO. There is hereby adopted as the salary pay schedule for all classification grades of positions in Section One of this ordinance, beginning with the bi-weekly pay period June 16, 1991, and extending through the bi-weekly pay period ending June 26, 1992;

SECTION THREE. The Circuit Attorney, in making appointments to the positions authorized by Section 56.540 R.S.Mo., shall make appointments to a class and grade as set out in Sections One and Two of this Ordinance and to an amount within a grade; provided further, the Circuit Attorney may, in his sole discretion, change the classification, grades and amount paid to a person appointed, as he is advised.

SECTION FOUR. The salaries for grades of positions shall be paid bi-weekly.

SECTION FIVE. The pay of an employee occupying a position allocated in Section One to a grade of 26G or lower, shall be eligible to receive, in addition to their regular salary, pay for overtime work authorized by the Circuit Attorney; such overtime wages shall be allowed on a basis of hours worked and at the bi-weekly rate.

Employees occupying positions allocated to a management grade designated by the letter "M" following the grade number or employees allocated to a professional grade designated by the letter "P" following the grade number, are ineligible to receive additional compensation for time worked over that ordinarily required.

SECTION SIX. This ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure as defined by Article IV, Section 20, of the Charter of the City of St. Louis and shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the mayor of the City of St. Louis.
