

St. Louis City Ordinance 62342

FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

BOARD BILL NO. [91] 84

INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN Phyllis Young , Mary Ross

An ordinance authorizing the Board of Public Service of the City of St. Louis to contract for the planning and design, materials and equipment, employ labor and consultants, pay salaries, fees and wages, enter into supplemental agreements with the Missouri Highway and Transportation Commission and other governmental agencies, accept monetary donations for the project and otherwise provide for a conceptual design to transform the open space over the depressed lanes of I-70 into a park like median at the Gateway Arch and appropriate the estimated cost of \$80,000.00 of which \$30,000.00 is the City's Share from the revolving Match Share Fund for Federal Aid to Urban Projects established by Ordinance 56931 and \$50,000 is available from State of Missouri Building Funds authorized by Ordinance 61058, containing sections for description of the work, estimated expenditure allocations, applicable state and federal wage rate requirements, equal opportunity provisions, the Mayor's Executive Orders, the Federal Court Order issued as a Consent Decree and a public work emergency clause.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:

Section One. The Board of Public Service is hereby authorized and directed to let contracts, provide for the planning and design, material and equipment, employ labor and consultants, pay salaries, fees and wages and otherwise provide for a conceptual design to transform the open space over the depressed lanes of I-70 into a park like median at the Gateway Arch.

Section Two. The design work authorized herein is estimated to cost and is hereby appropriated to be Eighty Thousand Dollars (\$80,000.00) of which the City's Share is Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$30,000.00) from funds in the Federal Aid to Urban Program Match Share Fund established by Ordinance 56931 approved March 14, 1975 and Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) from State of Missouri Building Funds authorized by Ordinance 61058 approved November 7, 1988. Said work shall be contracted and done in parts as funds are accrued in the Match Share Fund and are adequate to pay the cost. Section Three. The Comptroller of the City of St. Louis is hereby authorized and directed to draw warrants from time to time and disburse funds appropriated by this ordinance and is further authorized to receive and disburse grant funds,

upon the signature and certification of vouchers, by the President of the Board of Public Service. Funds received shall be deposited in to the Federal Aid to Urban Program Match Share Fund Ordinance 56931 and Ordinance 61058 as appropriate.

Section Four. All contracts let under authority of this ordinance shall provide that no less than the prevailing hourly rate of wages in the City of St. Louis, as determined by the Federal Davis-Bacon Act and the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations of the State of Missouri (Section 290.210 through 290.340 RSMo 1980) for each craft or type of work needed in the actual labor on the work herein authorized, as well as the general prevailing rate of pay for legal holidays and overtime work shall be paid to all works. All contracts let in connection with the constructions provided for herein shall be subject to, and in conformance with all statutes of the State of Missouri and the Charter and code of the City of St. Louis.

Section Five. The Board of Public Service of the City of St. Louis is hereby authorized to enter into supplemental agreements with the Missouri Highway and Transportation Commission and other governmental agencies for the project hereinbefore mentioned.

Section Six. The Board of Public Service is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City monetary donations from other governmental agencies to assist in paying for the work authorized in this ordinance. Funds received shall be deposited into the Federal Aid to Urban Program Match Share Fund Ordinance 56931 and Ordinance 61058 as appropriate.

Section Seven. All contracts approved and awarded by the Board of Public Service under authority of this ordinance shall provide for compliance with the Mayor's Executive Orders on Equal Opportunity and the Federal Court Order issued as a Consent Decree, except when otherwise superseded or prohibited by federal or state regulations.

Section Eight. This being an ordinance providing for public work or improvements, an emergency is hereby declared to exist within the meaning of Section Twenty, Article Four of the Charter of the City of St. Louis, and this ordinance shall be come effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
