

St. Louis City Ordinance 62347

FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

BOARD BILL NO. [91] 121

INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN MARTIE ABOUSSIE

An ordinance, recommended by the Board of Estimate and Apportionment, to release the sum of \$125,000 received from the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development under Section 108 of Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended, (the "Section 108 Funds") from the prior appropriation by the Board of Aldermen under Ordinance No. 62275 for certain land acquisition projects; appropriating the sum of \$50,000 of the Section 108 Funds for certain economic development projects; appropriating the sum of \$75,000 of the Section 108 Funds for certain neighborhood housing projects; authorizing and directing the Director of the Community Development Agency ("CDA"), upon approval of the Community Development Commission ("CDC"), to contract with municipal agencies, non-profit corporations and other entities as necessary for the expenditure of the funds which are the subject of this ordinance, and directing the Comptroller to issue warrants thereon upon the City Treasury; and containing an emergency clause.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance No. 62275 adopted by the Board of Aldermen on March 8, 1991, the sum of \$14,700,000 was appropriated for those certain neighborhood housing, economic development and land acquisition projects described therein; and

WHEREAS, \$125,000 of the amount appropriated under Ordinance No. 62275 for land acquisition projects will not be utilized for such purpose and should be released for reappropriation; and

WHEREAS, the City has identified certain appropriation needs in the areas of economic development and neighborhood housing.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:

Section One. There is hereby released from the appropriation made pursuant to Ordinance No. 62275 \$50,000 of the Section 108 Funds appropriated for the purpose of Land Acquisition for the Grand/Arsenal Commercial Project, reducing the appropriation for the purpose of Land Acquisition for the

Grand/Arsenal Commercial Project to \$200,000 and the total appropriation of Section 108 Funds for land acquisition projects to \$2,850,000.

Section Two. There is hereby further released from the appropriation made pursuant to Ordinance No. 62275 \$75,000 of the Section 108 Funds appropriated for the purpose of Land Acquisition for the Hamilton Heights Neighborhood Organization, reducing the appropriation for the purpose of Land Acquisition for the Hamilton Heights Neighborhood Organization to \$75,000 and the total appropriation of Section 108 Funds for land acquisition projects to \$2,775,000.

Section Three. There is hereby appropriated the sum of \$50,000 of Section 108 Funds for the purpose of Economic Development for the Grand/Arsenal Commercial Project, increasing the appropriation made pursuant to Ordinance No. 62275 for the purpose of Economic Development for the Grand/Arsenal Project to \$150,000 and the total appropriation of Section 108 Funds for economic development projects to \$2,950,000. The Director of CDA, upon the approval of CDC, is hereby authorized to make, negotiate and execute any and all contracts or other documents on behalf of the City which are necessary to carry out said activities and to expend said funds for the purposes and in the amounts specified, and the Comptroller is authorized and directed to issue warrants upon the City Treasury for payment thereon.

Section Four. There is hereby further appropriated the sum of \$75,000 of Section 108 Funds for the purpose of Neighborhood Housing for the Hamilton Heights Neighborhood Organization, increasing the appropriation made pursuant to Ordinance No. 62275 for the purpose of Neighborhood Housing for the Hamilton Heights Neighborhood Organization to \$225,000 and the total appropriation of Section 108 Funds for neighborhood housing projects to \$8,975,000. The Director of CDA, upon the approval of CDC, is hereby authorized to make, negotiate and execute any and all contracts or other documents on behalf of the City which are necessary to carry out said activities and to expend said funds for the purposes and in the amounts specified, and the Comptroller is authorized and directed to issue warrants upon the City Treasury for payment thereon.

Section Five. Upon the recommendation of CDC and with the approval of the Board of Estimate and Apportionment, the Mayor is hereby authorized to transfer funds between designated projects within each of the categories of neighborhood housing, economic Page 3 of 4 development and land acquisition as appropriated pursuant to Ordinance No. 62275 and amended hereby.

Section Six. This being an ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety and for providing public works, an emergency is hereby declared to exist within the meaning of Section 20, Article VI of the Charter and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
