

St. Louis City Ordinance 62351

FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

BOARD BILL NO. [91] 111

INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN JOANNE WAYNE

An ordinance recommended by the Airport Commission and the board of Estimate and Apportionment appropriating the sum of Three Million Dollars (\$3,000,000.00) from the Airport Development Fund into a Ordinance No. 62150, approved December 20, 1990 to be used for the acquisition and clearance of real property for noise mitigation purposes as authorized by Ordinance No. 62025, approved July 16, 1990, which acquired and cleared property will be sold to the Lambert St. Louis International Airport Corporation, a not for profit corporation, under the terms and conditions of the lease/purchase agreement authorized and set forth in said Ordinance No. 62025; authorizing and directing that all money received from the sale of said property be deposited in said Ordinance No.62150 and be used exclusively to purchase and clear other properties authorized to be acquired and cleared for noise mitigation purposes by said Ordinance No. 62025; authorizing the Director of Airports to make such applications and provide such data as necessary to seek reimbursement from the Federal Aviation Administration; and containing an emergency clause.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 62150, appropriated the sum of Thirteen Million Dollars (\$13,000,000.00) to be used for the acquisition and clearance of real property for noise mitigation purposes as authorized by Ordinance No. 62025, approved July 16, 1990; and

WHEREAS, said original appropriation has been spent and there is an urgent need for an additional appropriation of Three Million Dollars (\$3,000,000.00) to continue the noise mitigation program;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE. There is hereby appropriated the sum of Three Million Dollars (\$3,000,000.00) from the Airport Development Fund established under the authority of Ordinance No. 59286, Section 13, approved October 26, 1984, into a Ordinance #62150 to be expended for the acquisition and clearance of the real property which is described by metes and bounds and authorized and directed to be acquired by Ordinance No. 62025, approved July 16, 1990.

SECTION TWO. After a parcel (or parcels) of said real property is acquired and cleared, said parcel (or parcels) shall be sold to the Lambert St. Louis International Airport Corporation, under the terms and conditions set forth in the Noise Mitigation Lease/Purchase Agreement authorized by and attached as an Exhibit to said Ordinance No. 62025.

SECTION THREE. All money received from the sale of said real property to the not for profit corporation shall be deposited into and expended for the acquisition and clearance of other parcels of land authorized by Ordinance No. 62025.

SECTION FOUR. The Director of Airports is hereby authorized to make such applications and provide such data as necessary to seek reimbursement from the Federal Aviation Administrative under the Airport Improvement Program and/or any applicable Federal Legislation for all or any portion of costs incurred for projects herein authorized where such costs are deemed eligible and monies made available for reimbursement under Federal Law and Contract.

SECTION FIVE. This being an Ordinance providing for Public Work and Improvement, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure as defined in Article IV Section 20 of the City Charter and shall become effective immediately upon its approval by the Mayor of the City of St. Louis.
