

St. Louis City Ordinance 62376

FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

BOARD BILL NO. [91] 135

INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN JOANNE WAYNE

An ordinance establishing a four (4) way stop intersection for all traffic approaching from any direction the intersection of Prange Avenue and Alcott Avenue, and designating each approach to said intersection as a designated stop intersection, for purposes of regulating traffic in all four (4) directions as the traffic lanes of Prange and Alcott Avenues respectively approach said intersection and containing a penalty clause and an emergency clause.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE. As ordinance establishing a four (4) way stop intersection by designating both Prange and Alcott Avenues respectfully as stop intersections so as to regulate all traffic traveling in any direction as the same approaches said intersection as a stop intersection, as is set forth in Section 17.08.050 of the Revised Code of the City of St. Louis, 1980.

SECTION TWO. PENALTY CLAUSE. Any person, firm, or corporation violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a Class I General Offense.

SECTION THREE. Emergency Clause. This being an ordinance for the preservation of public peace, health and safety, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure within the meaning of Sections 19 and 20 of Article IV of the Charter of the City of St. Louis and shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
