

St. Louis City Ordinance 62377

FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

BOARD BILL NO. [91] 136

INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN JOANNE WAYNE

An ordinance establishing a stop intersection at the southwest corner of Lillian Avenue and Arlington Avenue, so as to require the flow of traffic on Lillian Avenue at its western approach to Arlington Avenue to observe said stop control, and containing a penalty clause and an emergency clause.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE. There is hereby created a stop intersection for all east bound traffic on Lillian Avenue at its intersection with Arlington Avenue; said stop device to be placed on the southwest corner of Lillian Avenue and Arlington Avenue.

SECTION TWO. PENALTY CLAUSE. Any person, firm, or corporation violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a Class I General Offense.

SECTION THREE. Emergency Clause. This being an ordinance for the preservation of public peace, health and safety, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure within the meaning of Sections 19 and 20 of Article IV of the Charter of the City of St. Louis and shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
