

# St. Louis City Ordinance 62378

FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

BOARD BILL NO. [91] 137

INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN JOANNE WAYNE

An ordinance establishing a stop sign at the Northeast corner of the intersection of Bircher Avenue at its intersection with Alcott Avenue so as to require all west bound traffic on Bircher Avenue to observe said stop sign as the approach Alcott Avenue and containing a penalty clause and an emergency clause.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE. There is hereby created a stop intersection for all west bound traffic on Bircher Avenue at its intersection with Alcott Avenue, said stop sign shall be placed on the northeast corner of Bircher Avenue and Alcott Avenue.

SECTION TWO. PENALTY CLAUSE. Any person, firm, or corporation violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a Class I General Offense.

SECTION THREE. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. This being an ordinance for the preservation of public peace, health and safety, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure within the meaning of Sections 19 and 20 of Article IV of the Charter of the City of St. Louis and shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
