

St. Louis City Ordinance 62439

FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

BOARD BILL NO. [91] 189

INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN MARIT CLARK, PHYLLIS YOUNG

An ordinance designating Mississippi Avenue at its intersection with Hickory Avenue as a Stop intersection for the purpose of regulating traffic on Mississippi Avenue and containing a penalty clause and an emergency clause.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE. Mississippi Avenue at the intersection with Hickory is hereby designated as a Stop intersection for the purpose of regulating traffic on Mississippi Avenue as set forth in Section 17.08.050 of the Revised Code of the City of St. Louis, 1980.

SECTION TWO. Any person, firm, or corporation violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of Class I General Offense.

SECTION THREE. The passage of this ordinance being deemed necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
