

St. Louis City Ordinance 62466

FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

BOARD BILL NO. [91] 183

INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN JOSEPH D. RODDY

An ordinance authorizing the Director of Streets to temporarily close Gibson Avenue at a point that when measuring at the centerline is approximately one hundred and fifty (150) feet north of the north curb line of Manchester Avenue for a period of six (6) months; and containing an emergency clause.

WHEREAS, the temporary closing of Gibson Avenue at a point that when measuring at the centerline is approximately one hundred and fifty (150) feet north of the north curb line of Manchester Avenue will enhance and increase the stability of the neighborhood adjacent to said street.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE: The Director of Streets is hereby authorized to temporarily close the following street:

Gibson Avenue at a point that when measuring at the centerline is approximately one hundred and fifty (150) feet north of the north curb line of Manchester Avenue for a period of six (6) months.

SECTION TWO: Emergency Clause. This being an Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure within the meaning of Sections 19 and 20 of Article IV of the Charter of the City of St. Louis and therefore this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
