FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

BOARD BILL NO. [91] 404

INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN PAUL MICHAEL BECKERLE

An ordinance repealing Ordinance 61055, approved October 25, 1988 pertaining to mechanical permits and inspection fees and certification of operators, as listed in Table M-100-A in lieu thereof a new ordinance pertaining to the same subject matter by revising said fees, and Table M-100-A and containing an emergency clause.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE. Ordinance 61055, approved October 25, 1988, is hereby repealed.

SECTION TWO. A new Table M-100-A is hereby enacted which should read as follows:

- c. Incremental (through the wall) cooling or heating/cooling units.
- d. Condensing units serving buildings of six (6) dwelling units or less.

All installations of ventilation systems (ducted) require a permit except ventilation systems under 5,000 cfm capacity.

SECTION THREE. Section M-1300.4. Annual Inspections. All refrigeration units of more than six (6) tons shall be inspected annually. The fee shall be as set forth in Table M-100-A.

SECTION FOUR. This being an ordinance for the preservation of public peace, health and safety, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure within the meaning of Sections 19 and 20 of Article IV of the Charter of the City of St. Louis and shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
