

# *St. Louis City Ordinance 62684*

FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

BOARD BILL NO. [92] 106

INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN JOANNE WAYNE

An ordinance establishing a stop intersection for traffic transversing Goodfellow Avenue in either direction, north or south, at the intersection of Goodfellow Avenue with Selber Court; requiring signs be posted, which notify traffic approaching said stop intersection that there is a stop intersection ahead; and containing penalty and emergency clauses.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE: There is hereby established boulevard stop signs for all traffic traveling north or south on Goodfellow Avenue at its intersection with Selber Court; requiring the traffic division to post appropriate warning signs notifying approaching traffic on Goodfellow of said stop sign at Selber Court.

SECTION TWO: PENALTY CLAUSE. Any person, firm, or corporation violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a Class I, General Offense.

SECTION THREE: EMERGENCY CLAUSE. This Ordinance, being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and general welfare, shall be and is hereby declared to be an emergency measure within the meaning of Article IV, Section 20, of the Charter of the City of St. Louis, and as such shall take effect immediately upon its approval by the Mayor.
