

St. Louis City Ordinance 62696

FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

BOARD BILL NO. [92] 80

INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN DANIEL J. GRUEN

An Ordinance establishing as a traffic control device, a stop sign on the southeast corner of Virginia at its intersection with Filmore so as to control the flow of traffic north bound on Virginia as it approaches Filmore Avenue, and containing an emergency clause.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE: There is hereby established a traffic control device being a stop intersection on the southeast corner of Virginia at its intersection with Filmore, controlling the flow of traffic north bound on Virginia as it approaches Filmore Avenue.

SECTION TWO: Emergency Clause. This being an ordinance for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure within the meaning of Sections 19 and 20 of Article IV of the Charter of the City of St. Louis and therefore this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
