

# *St. Louis City Ordinance 62801*

## FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

BOARD BILL NO. [92] 137

## INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN MARTIE ABOUSSIE

An ordinance implementing the authority granted and conferred by House Bill 156 of the 85th General Assembly wherein Section 87.095 RSMo 1986, was by said House Bill repealed and a new section dealing with the same subject matter was therein proposed for enactment and was in fact adopted as made and provided; containing an emergency clause.

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE. In addition to any other benefit to which an active or retired fire fighter may be entitled they shall be entitled to the following benefit approved by the General Assembly of this State and hereby adopted enacted into the laws and ordinances of this City, namely:

Whenever an active or retired fireman shall die, as aforesaid, the board of trustees shall appropriate from the fund a sum not exceeding one hundred and fifty dollars to the widow or family for funeral expenses. In cities not within a county the payment for funeral expenses shall be two thousand dollars, and shall be paid solely from moneys within the pension fund.

SECTION TWO. Any benefits paid pursuant to Section One of this Ordinance shall be paid only from the Future Benefit Fund established by Ordinance 61980.

SECTION THREE. Emergency Clause. This Ordinance, being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and general welfare, shall be and is hereby declared to be an emergency measure within the meaning of Article IV, Section 20, of the Charter of the City of St. Louis, and as such shall take effect immediately upon its approval by the Mayor.
