

St. Louis City Ordinance 62850

FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

BOARD BILL NO. [92] 305

INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN JO ANNE WAYNE

An Ordinance ratifying and adopting the actions of the Mayor and the Comptroller in accepting and executing on behalf of the City of St. Louis a certain Grant Agreement offered by the United States of America, acting through the Federal Aviation Administration of the United States Department of Transportation, said Agreement being for Project Number 3 29 0085 25, Contract Number DTFA09 92 A 40082, dated September 29, 1992, for maximum Federal obligation of One Million, One Hundred Eighty two Thousand, Five Hundred Twenty five Dollars (\$1,182,525.00), which is filed in the Office of the City Register, to install FAR Part 139 guidance signs to meet requirements of Advisory Circular 5340 18c all as more particularly described in the Project Application Grant; and containing an emergency clause.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:

Section One. The actions of the Mayor and Comptroller in accepting and executing on behalf of the City of St. Louis, a certain Grant Agreement offered by the United States of America, acting through the Federal Aviation Administration of the United States Department of Transportation, said Agreement being for Project Number 3 29 0085 25, Contract Number DTFA09 92 A 40082, dated September 29, 1992, for a maximum Federal obligation of One Million, One Hundred Eighty Two Thousand, Five Hundred Twenty five (\$1,182,525.00) for activities authorized in the aforementioned Grant Agreement to install FAR Part 139 guidance signs to meet requirements of Advisory Circular 5340 18c all as more particularly described in the Project Application of the Grant, which Grant Agreement is filed in the Office of the City Register as Document Number 16008 , are hereby ratified and approved.

Section Two. All terms, conditions, statements, warranties, representations, covenants, agreements and assurances contained in the Project Application and incorporated materials referred to in the Grant Agreement are hereby ratified and approved as if they were set forth herein verbatim.

Section Three. This being an Ordinance providing for a Public Work and Improvement Program, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure as

defined in Article IV, Section 20 of the City Charter, and shall become effective immediately upon approval by the Mayor of the City of St. Louis.
