

*St. Louis City Ordinance 62877*

FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

BOARD BILL NO. [92] 299

INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN JOSEPH D. RODDY , ROBERT RUGGERI

An ordinance designating Manchester Avenue at its intersection with Sublette Avenue as a stop intersection for the purpose of regulating traffic on Manchester Avenue and containing an emergency clause.

WHEREAS, the intersection of Manchester Avenue at its intersection with Sublette Avenue is presently a controlled intersection by regulating traffic on Sublette Avenue; and

WHEREAS, it is now necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety that the intersection be a three-way stop intersection.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE. Manchester Avenue at its intersection with Sublette Avenue is hereby designated as a stop intersection for the purpose of regulating traffic on Manchester Avenue.

SECTION TWO. This being an ordinance for the preservation of public peace, health and safety, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure within the meaning of Sections 19 and 20 of Article IV of the Charter of the City of St. Louis and therefore this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
