

St. Louis City Ordinance 62903

FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN JoAnne Wayne

An Ordinance recommended by the Airport Commission, the Board of Public Service and the Board of Estimate and Apportionment appropriating the total sum of One Million Four Hundred Fifty two Thousand Dollars (\$1,452,000.00) from the Airport Construction Improvement Project Fund to provide for a Public Work and Improvement Program at Lambert St. Louis International Airport, consisting of but not limited to the planning and design, construction management, material testing and construction of Airfield Guidance Signs, as itemized in Section One of this Ordinance; authorizing and directing the Board of Public Service to let contracts therefor and otherwise provide for the aforementioned work in compliance with applicable MBE/WBE and/or DBE requirements and in compliance with applicable Federal, State and local laws, ordinances, regulations, court decisions and executive orders relating to equal employment opportunity; authorizing and directing the Comptroller of the City of St. Louis to draw warrants from time to time on the Treasurer of the City of St. Louis for payment of expenses authorized herein upon submission of properly certified vouchers in conformance with procedures established by said Comptroller; authorizing the Director of Airports to make such applications and provide such data as necessary to seek reimbursement from the Federal Aviation Administration under the Airport Improvement Program and/or any applicable Federal legislation for all or any portion of costs incurred for projects herein authorized where such costs are deemed eligible and monies made available for reimbursement under Federal Law; and containing an emergency clause.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:

Section One. The Board of Public Service is hereby authorized and directed to let contracts and otherwise provide for a Public Work and Improvement Program at Lambert St. Louis International Airport, consisting of but not limited to the planning and design, construction management, material testing and construction of the aforementioned Airfield Guidance Sign improvements consisting of the installation of approximately 155 new guidance signs and bases, the relocation of approximately 169 existing signs including new base construction, the modification of existing runway/taxiway circuits, the installation of regulators, the removal of existing sign bases and other related

work at an estimated cost of One Million Four Hundred Fifty two Thousand Dollars (\$1,452,000.00). All contracts let under authority of this Ordinance shall be in compliance with all applicable MBE/WBE and/or DBE requirements and in compliance with all applicable Federal, State and local laws, ordinances, regulations, court decisions and executive orders relating to equal employment opportunity.

Section Two. There is hereby appropriated the sum of One Million Four Hundred Fifty two Thousand Dollars (\$1,452,000.00) from the Airport Construction Improvement Project Fund established under authority of Ordinance 62742, approved November 16, 1992, to be expended for costs authorized herein under Section One of this Ordinance.

Section Three. The Comptroller of the City of St. Louis is hereby authorized to draw warrants from time to time on the Treasurer of the City of St. Louis for payment of expenses authorized herein upon submission of properly certified vouchers in conformance with procedures established by said Comptroller.

Section Four. The Director of Airports is hereby authorized to make such applications and provide such data as necessary to seek reimbursement from the Federal Aviation Administration under the Airport Improvement Program and/or any applicable Federal Legislation for all or any portion of costs incurred for projects herein authorized where such costs are deemed eligible and monies made available for reimbursement under Federal Law and/or Contract.

Section Five. This being an Ordinance providing for Public Work and Improvement, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure as defined in Article IV, Section 20, of the City Charter, and shall become effective immediately upon its approval by the Mayor of the City of St. Louis.
