

St. Louis City Ordinance 62936

FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

BOARD BILL NO. [93] ENTER BB#&YR

INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN JoAnne Wayne

An ordinance authorizing and directing that stop signs be erected controlling east bound traffic on Bircher Avenue at its confluence and intersections with east bound traffic leaving Highway I-70 at Union Avenue and Kingshighway Boulevard. Thereby requiring all east bound traffic on Bircher to stop at said Bircher Avenue's confluence and intersections with Highway I-70's exit ramps at Union Avenue and Kingshighway Boulevard.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE. It is hereby authorized and directed that stop signs be erected requiring all east bound traffic on Bircher Avenue to stop where said Bircher Avenue meets and intersects with the exit ramps for east bound traffic at of Highway I-70 at Union Avenue and Kingshighway Boulevard.

SECTION TWO. This Ordinance, being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and general welfare, shall be and is hereby declared to be an emergency measure within the meaning of Article IV, Section 20, of the Charter of the City of St. Louis, and as such shall take effect immediately upon its approval by the Mayor.
