

## *St. Louis City Ordinance 62982*

FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN MARIT CLARK , MARY ROSS , MARTIE J. ABOUSSIE , FREEMAN BOSLEY, SR. , PHYLLIS YOUNG , JAMES F. SHREWSBURY , PAUL MICHAEL BECKERLE , FRANCIS G. SLAY

An ordinance authorizing and directing the Mayor on behalf of the City of St. Louis to submit applications and to take other necessary actions for funds under the Bureau of Justice Assistance Police Hiring Supplement Program, ("Police Supplement Program"), to provide for the hiring and/or rehiring of additional sworn law enforcement officers as part of an overall plan or strategy to address crime and related problems through community policing and said grants requiring a twenty-five percent assurance from the City, and containing an emergency clause.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE. The Mayor of the City of St. Louis is hereby authorized and directed, on behalf of the City of St. Louis, to submit applications for funds, and to make all other arrangements and to take all other actions pursuant to, contemplated by, and/or incidental to the receipt of funds under the Bureau of Justice Assistance Police Hiring Supplement Program, ("Police Supplement Program"). Said grants of funds shall provide for the hiring and/or rehiring of additional sworn law enforcement officers as part of an overall plan or strategy to address crime and related problems through community policing, as set forth in the Police Supplement Program, and the application for said funds will require the Mayor of the City of St. Louis to make assurances to the Department of Justice, including assurances that the City will provide a percentage, (at least 25%), of the total salary of officers funded under the Police Supplement Program over the life of the grant, subject to the annual appropriations provisions of the Charter and Revised Code of the City of St. Louis.

SECTION TWO. Emergency Clause. This being an ordinance for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety, it is hereby declared to be an immediate measure within the meaning of Sections 19 and 20 of Article IV of the Charter of the City of St. Louis and therefore this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
