

## *St. Louis City Ordinance 62985*

FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

An ordinance, recommended by the Board of Estimate and Apportionment, authorizing a supplemental appropriation amending Ordinance 62883 in the amount of One Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,500,000) from anticipated proceeds of the 3/8 cent sales tax for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1994, to Fund 1010, Department 650, Account 5101 to provide to all full-time uniformed and non-uniformed employees of the City of St. Louis Metropolitan Police Department during the current fiscal year a total sum of \$700 either in bi-weekly increments or lump sum or a combination of both in addition to the compensation presently authorized by the St. Louis Metropolitan Board of Police Commissioners .

WITNESSETH, THAT,

WHEREAS, on August 3, 1993 City voters approved a 3/8 cent sales tax; and

WHEREAS, the Budget Division anticipates revenues in excess of One Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,500,000) accruing to general revenue from proceeds from the 3/8 cent sales tax during the fiscal year ending June 30, 1994; and

WHEREAS, the Charter, Article XVI, Section 6, authorizes supplemental appropriations upon the recommendation of the Board of Estimate and Apportionment.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE. Pursuant to the recommendation of the Board of Estimate and Apportionment, there is hereby authorized a supplemental appropriation amending Ordinance 62883 in the amount of One Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,500,000) from anticipated proceeds from the 3/8 cent sales tax to Fund 1010, Department 650, Account 5101 to provide to all full-time uniformed and non-uniformed employees of the City of St. Louis

Metropolitan Police Department during the current fiscal year a total sum of \$700 either in bi-weekly increments or lump sum or a combination of both in addition to the compensation presently authorized by the St. Louis Metropolitan Board of Police Commissioners.

SECTION TWO. Emergency Clause. This being an ordinance for the preservation of public peace, health and safety, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure within the meaning of Sections 19 and 20 of Article IV of the Charter of the City of St. Louis and therefore this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
