

# *St. Louis City Ordinance 63010*

FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

BOARD BILL NO. [93] 196

INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN JOANNE WAYNE

An ordinance to change the zoning of property as indicated on District Map to the "D" Multiple Family Dwelling District so as to include the described parcels of land in city block 4994 and containing an emergency clause.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE. The zoning designation of certain real property in city block 4994 is hereby changed to the "D" Multiple Family Dwelling District, real property being more particularly described as follows:

Parcel I.

BEGINNING at a point in city block 4994, said point being on the north line of Kennerly Avenue at the point of intersection thereof with the west line of Hamilton Avenue; thence westwardly, along said north line of Kennerly Avenue a distance of 660 feet, more or less, to a point; thence northwardly, and parallel to the said west line of Hamilton Avenue, a distance of 134.75 feet, more or less, to a point; thence eastwardly, and parallel to said north line of Kennerly Avenue to a point, said point being the point of intersection with the west line of Hamilton Avenue; thence southwardly, along said west line of Hamilton Avenue to the point of intersection thereof with said north line of Kennerly Avenue, said point being the point of beginning.

SECTION TWO. This ordinance being necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare, is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance under Article IV, Section 19 and 20 of the City Charter, and it shall take effect and be in full force immediately upon its approval by the Mayor.
