An ordinance providing for the submission to the voters of the City of St. Louis at an election to be held on the 7th day of June 1994 the question of a tax increase of 18 cents on each one hundred dollars assessed valuation over the present tax of 38 cents on each one hundred dollars assessed valuation for the free public library; providing for the manner of voting on such question; and providing for the levying of such tax if a majority of all votes cast on such question shall be for such tax increase; with an emergency clause.

Whereas, the Board of Directors of the St. Louis Public Library has petitioned the Mayor and the Board of Aldermen, in writing, for an increased tax of 18 cents on each one hundred dollars assessed valuation over the present annual tax of 38 cents on each one hundred dollars assessed valuation of all taxable property in the city, to be levied for the maintenance and rehabilitation of the free public library heretofore established in said city.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE. The following question is hereby submitted to the qualified voters of the City of St. Louis and shall be voted upon at an election to be held as hereinafter provided. The question shall read in words and figures as follows:

Shall there be a tax increase of 18 cents over the present 38 cent tax per hundred dollars assessed valuation for the free public library?

SECTION TWO. The foregoing question shall be submitted to the qualified voters at an election to be held on June 7, 1994, and, if a majority of all the votes cast on the question is for the tax submitted, the tax of 56 cents for the free public library, shall be levied and collected in like manner with other general taxes of the City and become a part of the "City Library Fund, " to be administered as provided in Section 182.440 R.S.Mo. The qualified voters may, at such election, vote a ballot in substantially the following form:

Shall there be a tax increase of 18 cents over the present 38 cent tax per hundred dollars assessed valuation for the free public library?

SECTION THREE. The Board of Election Commissioners of the City of St. Louis shall provide the ballots or voting machines, or both, and conduct the election and shall ascertain the results thereof according to the laws regulating such elections. Upon approval of this ordinance it shall be published once in the City Journal. Proof of publication of this ordinance shall be made by affidavit of the City Register and such affidavit shall be filed to the office of the City Register and a copy of said publication shall be attached thereto.

SECTION FOUR. This being an ordinance calling and providing for an election of and vote by, and submission to the people, it is declared to be an emergency measure within the meaning of the Charter of the City of St. Louis, and shall take effect and be in force from and after its adoption and approval by the Mayor.
