An ordinance pertaining to abandoned vehicles, repealing Ordinance 62776, approved December 7, 1992 pertaining to the removal of vehicles or parts of vehicles on private property and the duration of impoundment and enacting in lieu thereof a new ordinance pertaining to the same subject matters and containing an emergency clause.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE. Ordinance 62776, approved December 7, 1992 is hereby repealed and enacted are new sections which shall read and be codified as follows:

17.56.070. On private land - notice of removal.

Whenever the Director of Streets clears land pursuant to Section 17.56.050 he, his agents, or contractor shall forthwith post a notice on the parcel of land notifying the owner of each land of the name and address of the place where such vehicle or parts shall be located for a period of ten (10) days.

17.56.150. Impoundment - duration.

Any vehicle or parts removed pursuant to Section 17.56.020 B1 through 7 inclusive shall be impounded for a period of thirty (30) days. Any vehicle or parts of vehicles removed pursuant to Section 17.56.020 B8 through 10 shall be impounded for a period of ten (10) days.

SECTION TWO. Emergency Clause. This being an ordinance for the preservation of public peace, health and safety, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure within the meaning of Sections 19 and 20 of Article IV of the Charter of the City of St. Louis and therefore this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
