

St. Louis City Ordinance 63186

FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

BOARD BILL NO. [94] 65

INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN IRVING CLAY, JR.

An ordinance permanently blocking Kingsbury Square East between Kingsbury Place and McPherson Avenue by erecting barricades at the alley running parallel between the two designated streets, said barricade to run from a line as follows: from the corner of the northwest quadrant diagonally southeast across said alley in an oblique manner connecting with the southeast quadrant of said intersection at said alley's intersection with Kingsbury Square East and containing an emergency clause.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE The Director of Streets is hereby authorized and directed to permanently close and barricade Kingsbury Square East at the alley running parallel with Kingsbury Place and McPherson Avenue, by blockading and barricading said alley in an oblique and diagonal manner, said blockade running generally from the northwest quadrant of said intersection diagonally southeast to the corner of the southeast quadrant of said alley at its intersection with Kingsbury Square East.

SECTION TWO. The passage of this Ordinance being deemed necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, it is hereby declared to be an emergency Ordinance as provided for by Article IV, Section 20 of the Charter of the City of St. Louis and shall be effective immediately upon approval by the Mayor.
