FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

BOARD BILL NO. [94] 179

INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN JOSEPH RODDY

An ordinance establishing a two-way stop for all traffic traveling on Taylor Avenue between Scott Avenue and McKinley Avenue, and containing an emergency clause.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE. An ordinance establishing a two-way stop on Taylor Avenue between Scott Avenue and McKinley Avenue at the locations where marked as proposed stop signs on the attached Exhibit which is made a part of the ordinance.

SECTION TWO. The passage of this Ordinance being deemed necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, it is hereby declared to be an emergency Ordinance as provided for by Article IV, Section 20 of the Charter of the City of St. Louis and shall be effective immediately upon approval by the Mayor.
