

## *St. Louis City Ordinance 63332*

FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

BOARD BILL NO. [94] 294

INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN GERALDINE OSBORN

An Ordinance recommended by the Airport Commission and the Board of Estimate and Apportionment, ratifying and adopting the actions of the Mayor and the Comptroller in accepting and executing on behalf of the City of St. Louis a certain Grant Agreement offered by the United States of America, acting through the Federal Aviation Administration of the United States Department of Transportation, said Agreement being for Project Number 3-29-0085-34, Contract Number DTFA09-94-A-40054, dated September 26, 1994, for a maximum Federal obligation of Two Million, Two Hundred Thirty-Three Thousand, Two Hundred Thirteen Dollars (\$2,233,213.00), which is filed in the Office of the City Register, for the expansion of the East Terminal Apron (approximately 71,200 s.y.) as more particularly described in the Project Application; and containing an emergency clause.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:

Section One. The actions of the Mayor and the Comptroller in accepting and executing on behalf of the City of St. Louis, a certain Grant Agreement offered by the United States of America, acting through the Federal Aviation Administration of the United States Department of Transportation, said Agreement being for Project Number 3-29-0085-34, Contract Number DTFA09-94-A-40054, dated September 26, 1994, for a maximum Federal obligation of Two Million, Two Hundred Thirty-Three Thousand, Two Hundred Thirteen Dollars (\$2,233,213.00), for activities authorized in the aforementioned Grant Agreement for the expansion of the East Terminal Apron, which is filed in the Office of the City Register as Document Number 77116, are hereby ratified and approved.

Section Two. All terms, conditions, statements, warranties, representations, covenants, agreements and assurances contained in the Project Application and incorporated materials referred to in the Grant Agreement are hereby ratified and approved as if they were set forth herein verbatim.

Section Three. This being an Ordinance providing for a Public Work and Improvement Program, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure as

defined in Article IV, Section 20 of the City Charter, and shall become effective immediately upon approval by the Mayor of the City of St. Louis.
