

*St. Louis City Ordinance 63376*

FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

BOARD BILL NO. [94] 255

INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN TERRY KENNEDY

An ordinance authorizing and directing the Director of Streets to temporarily close, barricade or otherwise impede the flow of north-south traffic on Whittier Avenue between Maryland and McPherson by blocking said traffic flow five feet north of the mouth of the alley that divides said streets, and containing an emergency clause.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE: The Director of Streets is hereby authorized to temporarily close and barricade Whittier Avenue, between Maryland and McPherson at a point 5 feet north of the mouth of the alley flowing into Whittier.

SECTION TWO: Emergency Clause. This being an ordinance for the preservation of public peace, health and safety, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure within the meaning of Sections 19 and 20 of Article IV of the Charter of the City of St. Louis and therefore this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
