

St. Louis City Ordinance 63457

FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

BOARD BILL NO. [94] 389

INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN STEPHEN J. CONWAY

An ordinance pertaining to service animals; amending Ordinance 60878, approved May 23, 1988, by repealing sections 10.04.020 and 10.04.030 of Section Two of said ordinance pertaining to guide dogs and enacting in lieu thereof one new section pertaining to service animals, and containing an emergency clause.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE. Sections 10.04.020 and 10.04.030 of Section Two of Ordinance 60878, approved May 23, 1988, are repealed.

SECTION TWO. A new Section 10.04.020 is hereby enacted which shall read us follows: 10.04.020. Service animals. It is unlawful for any service animal trained to guide or assist a person with a disability, including those persons with mobility, visual or hearing impairments, when actually accompanying this person with a disability, to be prohibited admission to any place or vehicle which a person with a disability has a lawful right to enter. The service animal must wear the proper restraints and/or harness. At all times, the service animal or person must have in or on their possession, identification of training as a service animal, for the service animal. The service animal is allowed to accompany the person with a disability in all areas or public accommodation open to other patrons. The service animal shall not be separated from the person with a disability that it serves.

SECTION THREE. This being an ordinance for the preservation of public peace, health and safety, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure within the meaning of Sections 19 and 20 of Article IV of the Charter of the City of St. Louis and therefore this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
