

St. Louis City Ordinance 63474

FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

BOARD BILL NO. [95] 40

INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN MARTIE ABOUSSIE

An ordinance amending Ordinance 51964, approved April 8, 1963 by naming a public park formally known a Pontiac Central Park, as therein described and dedicated, as the "Fremont Park", and containing an emergency clause.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE. Ordinance 51964, approved April 8, 1963 is hereby amended to name a public park formally known as Pontiac Central Park, as therein described and dedicated, to be known as the "Fremont Park".

SECTION TWO. That the public park formally known as Pontiac Central Park be named the "Fremont Park" as a result of the passage of this Ordinance and is described as follows:

Land in City Block 1416, bounded north by the south line of Lynch Street, 50 feet wide, and abutting thereon 129 feet 4 1/2 inches, bounded east by the west line of the north-south alley, 15 feet wide, in said City Block and abutting thereon 262 feet 9 1/4 inches, bounded south by a line 12 feet 6 inches south of and parallel to the south line of lot 18 in said City Block, and abutting thereon 129 feet 4 1/2 inches, bounded west by the east line of Wisconsin Avenue, 60 feet wide and abutting thereon 263 feet 1/2 inches.

Also land in City Block 1416, bounded north by the south line of Lynch Street, 50 feet wide, and abutting thereon 129 feet 4 1/2 inches, bounded east by the west line of Salena Street, 50 feet wide, and abutting thereon 249 feet 8 inches, bounded south by the south line of lot 9 in said City Block and abutting thereon 129 feet 4 1/2 inches, bounded west by the east line of the north-south alley in aid City Block, and abutting thereon 250 feet 1 1/2 inches.

Also land in City Block 1417, bounded north by the south line of Lynch Street, 50 feet wide, and abutting thereon 124 feet 10 1/2 inches, bounded east by the west line of Wisconsin Avenue, 60 feet wide, and abutting thereon 275 feet 10 inches, bounded south by the south line of lot 11 in said City Block, and abutting thereon 124 feet 10 1/2 inches, bounded west by the east line of the

north-south alley, in said City Block, and abutting thereon 276 feet 3 1/2 inches.

SECTION THREE. That a proper and fitting commemorative marker as approved by the Director of Parks of the City of St. Louis, shall be located on said park grounds.

SECTION FOUR. This ordinance being deemed necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health safety and welfare, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage and approval by the Mayor.
