

St. Louis City Ordinance 63476

FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

BOARD BILL NO. [95] 55

INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN FRANCIS G. SLAY

An ordinance, recommended by the Board of Estimate and Apportionment, authorizing a supplemental appropriation amending Ordinance 63152 in the amount of Four Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$450,000) from anticipated property tax revenues for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1995, to Fund 1010, Department 650, Account 5101, to partially fund during the current fiscal year a bonus equal to 2% of current salary to all full-time uniformed and non-uniformed employees of the St. Louis Metropolitan Police Department and as recommended, in addition to the Board of Estimate and Apportionment, by the Civil Service Commission a supplemental appropriation of five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000.00) from anticipated property tax revenues for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1995 to Fund 1010, Department 611, Account 5101, to fund during the current fiscal year a bonus equal to 2% of current salary to all uniformed employees of the St. Louis Fire Department, in addition to the compensation presently authorized by the St. Louis Metropolitan Board of Police Commissioners and the City of St. Louis, and containing an emergency clause.

WHEREAS, the City anticipates general fund revenues from property taxes for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1995, to be in excess of the amount originally appropriated; and

WHEREAS, the Charter, Article XVI, Section 6, authorizes supplemental appropriations upon the recommendation of the Board of Estimate and Apportionment.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE. Pursuant to the recommendation of the Board of Estimate and Apportionment, there is hereby authorized a supplemental appropriation amending Ordinance 63152 in the amount of \$450,000 from the anticipated general fund revenues for property taxes for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1995 to Fund 1010, Department 650, Account 5101, to partially fund during the current fiscal year a bonus equal to 2% of current salary to all full-time uniformed and non-uniformed employees of the St. Louis Metropolitan Police Department and pursuant to the recommendations of the Board of Estimate and

Apportionment and the Civil Service Commission, \$500,000.00 to Fund 1010, Department 611, Account 5101, to fund during the current fiscal year a bonus equal to 2% of current salary to all uniformed employees of the St. Louis Fire Department, in addition to the compensation presently authorized by the St. Louis Metropolitan Board of Police Commissioners, and the City of St. Louis. The Board of Police Commissioners shall determine whether said monies shall be paid in bi-weekly increments or lump sum, or combination of both, for all full time uniformed and non-uniformed employees of the City of St. Louis Metropolitan Police Department and the Director of Personnel of the City of St. Louis shall determine whether said monies shall be paid in bi-weekly increments or lump sum, or combination of both, for all uniformed employees of the St. Louis Fire Department.

SECTION TWO. Emergency Clause. This being an ordinance for the preservation of public peace, health and safety, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure within the meaning of Sections 19 and 20 of Article IV of the Charter of the City of St. Louis and therefore this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
